ENTRY FEE

Registration fee 30€ per "Cadet-Junior-Senior" fighter & 20€ per "Benjamin-Minime-Master" fighter, 20€ per coach (fighters can coach (18 years old) but will have to pay the double registration fee and have a "coach" outfit as mentioned in the "access to the area" section. A card with the mention "coach" (nominative) will be given at the delivery of the accreditations.

ANY FAILURE OR REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH THE COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE FEDERATION WILL BE PENALISED.

Any change of category from KIDS to PRECADETS, PRECADETS to Cadets, and Cadets to Juniors will be REFUSED.

KIDS Male - Female

Fighting area: 8mx8m

Timing: 2 winning rounds x 1mn with 30s rest between each repetition (elimination and final - Direct elimination)

Clothing: White-collar dobok for Keups / red/black collar for Pooms / black collar for Dans.

System: Kicks and punches to the chest

Protection: Shin, ulna and genital protectors, helmet, mittens, electronic fists and mouth guards recommended.

PRECADETS Male-Female

Fighting area: 10mx10m

Timing: 2 winning rounds x 1mn with 30s rest between each round (elimination rounds and finals - direct elimination)

Clothing: White-collar dobok for Keups / red/black collar for Pooms / black collar for Dans.

System: Kicks and punches to the chest

Protection: Tibial, ulnar, genital, helmet, mittens, electronic mittens, mouth guards recommended.

Dae Do - GEN 2 - GEN 1 and GEN 2 electronic pits AUTHORISED

Fighting area: 10mx 10m

Timing: 2 winning rounds x 1mn30 with 1mn rest between each round (elimination and final - direct elimination)

Clothing: White-collared dobok for Keups / red/black collar for Pooms / black collar for Dans.

System: Kicks to the chest and helmet, punches to the chest.

Protections: Tibial, ulnar, genital, mittens, mouth guards.

JUNIORS Male&Female

Fighting area: 10mx 10m

Running time: 2 winning rounds x 2 min / 1 min rest between each round (elimination rounds and finals - direct elimination)

Finals will be 2 winning rounds x 2 minutes with 1 minute rest between each restart Clothing: White-collar dobok for Keups, red/black collar for Pooms and black collar for Dans. System: Kicks to the chest and helmet, punches to the chest.

Attire: Dobok with white collar for Keups, / red/black collar for Pooms and black collar for Dans.

System: Kicks to the chest and helmet, punches to the chest.

Protection: Tibial, ulnar, genital, helmet, breastplate, mitts, mittens, mouth guard.

Electronic chest protectors Dae Do GEN 1- Mittens GEN1 and GEN 2 AUTHORISED The time of the bouts may be modified by the organiser for the good progress of the competition.

Masters Male & Female

Fighting area: 10mx 10m

Execution time: 2 winning rounds x 1.30 mn / 1min rest between each round (elimination and final - direct elimination)

The finals will be 2 x 1.30 minutes with 1 minute rest between each round.

Attire: Dobok with white collar for Keups, / red/black collar for Pooms and black collar for Dans.

System: Kicks to the chest and helmet, punches to the chest.

Protection: Tibial, ulnar, genital, electronic bubble helmet, breastplate, mittens, mouth guard. Electronic chest protectors Dae Do GEN 1- Mittens GEN1 AND GEN 2 AUTHORISED The time of the bouts may be modified by the organiser for the good progress of the competition.

Access to the combat area:

- Only competitors, coaches, officials and referees have access to the combat areas.
- Fighters may be coached (18 years old) while respecting the following dress code.
- Coaches will present themselves in tracksuits and sports shoes,
 bareheaded, with a white towel and a small transparent bottle of water.
 There will be no advertising on the fighters' doboks.
 - Only the name of the fighter or the country to which he belongs may appear.
 - The referees will be dressed in correct uniform:
 - The doctor assisted by his team of first-aiders.

In the event of a dispute, only the coach has the right to go to the jury table after paying the sum of 100 €. Deadline for complaints: 10 minutes after the bout.
